What: The placement assessment you must take to enter ECTC if you have not taken the ACT or your ACT scores are not sufficient. The assessment is free 1 time per year. You must have an application to ECTC on file prior to testing. Go to (<https://www.elizabethtown.kctcs.edu/forms/admisapp/>) to apply for admission.

Where: Room 402, CRPEC building. If you have any questions please call us at (270) 706-8809. The assessment takes approximately 1^{1/2} hours. (COMPASS is also available at the Ft Knox Center. Call 502-942-0101 for an appointment, or call ACES at 502-624-7517.)

Why: Your advisor will use your scores to place you in the courses that will help you succeed at ECTC. It is very important that you take this seriously. If your scores aren't sufficient for college level work you will be placed in developmental courses to get you ready for college.
