TUITION & FEES

Tuition will be assessed per credit hour at the rate of \$125.00 for resident students and \$425.00 for non-resident students. Web courses offered through ECTC will be assessed at the rate of \$125.00 per credit hour.

FEE PAYMENT

Refer to the Academic Calendar for fee payment deadlines. Approved second party payments (scholarships, Voc. Rehab., Pell Grant, etc.) must be verified in the **Business Office** by the appropriate deadline. Students who register but are not able to attend must officially withdraw by the last day to receive a 100% refund listed in the calendar above to avoid having a penalty assessed to their account.

Payment may be made by mail or in person by cash, personal check, Visa/Mastercard/Discover, money order or certified check. Checks returned by a bank will result in tuition liability in accordance with the refund policy and a \$25.00 service charge on each check.

REFUND POLICY

All drop slips must be officially processed by the Student Records Office, Room 104 ATB. Check the Summer Academic Calendar for refund percentage dates. Refunds are subject to review by the Financial Aid and Student Billings Office. Fee Payment Plan charges and KET fees are non-refundable and not included in the Refund Policy.
